For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and delay of 93 days in filing of the appeal is condoned.

Learned counsel for the appellant has produced copy of order dated 25.03.2022, which shows that the present appellant along with respondent No.1 had approached the Court of Sessions Judge, Rupnagar for protection of their lives and liberty. A perusal of this order further shows that the appellant-Gagandeep Kaur and respondent No.1-Gurdeep Singh had submitted their affidavits and made statements that they had performed marriage as per Sikh rites on 20.03.2022. Learned counsel for the appellant has stated that as per Panchayati Compromise (Annexure A-1), engagement ceremony of the appellant and respondent No.1 had been cancelled on 20.03.2022. He further stated that on this ground, vide impugned order

dated 17.05.2022, the appellant cannot be restrained from solemnizing the marriage. He further stated that there is no chance of amicable settlement between the parties.

Keeping in view that this question of fact has to be examined by the Family Court, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Principal Judge, Family Court, Rupnagar to decide the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
