The present petition has been filed under Section 438 to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.385 dated 22.07.2022 under Section 21(b)/29/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad.

A perusal of the petition reveals that as per para no.16, the petitioner declares no criminal history.

On the contrary, learned State counsel submits that at page 21 of the petition, learned Additional and Sessions Judge, Fatehabad has mentioned that the petitioner is involved in one more case under NDPS Act, which clearly shows that the petitioner has criminal antecedents.

Given above, the present petition stands dismissed with liberty to file fresh petition by disclosing all criminal history alongwith bail orders of those cases.

It is clarified that dismissal of the present petition shall not come in the way in case fresh petition is filed.
