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**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):**

This petition was filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 718 dated 20.9.2019, under Sections 18 and 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Karnal.

One of the argument address was that the petitioner was not apprehended from the alleged spot as claimed by the police officials.

As per the case set up, recovery from the petitioner is of 412 grams of opium i.e. Non-commercial quantity.

The petitioner was granted interim bail on 1.11.2019.

There is no allegation of mis-usage of the interim bail granted.

As per learned counsel for the State, investigation is complete and challan is to be presented.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, the interim protection granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
