The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the re-audit report dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-4) by referring that the same is in contradiction to the rules and regulations appended as Annexure P-5.

Apparently, Annexure P-5 is not a rule and regulation and is only a guideline for appointment of auditors. There is no prohibition contained in any law against re-audit.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition.
