Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for grant of parole for a period of 10 weeks.

On 21.11.2022, directions were issued to the competent authority to take a decision on the representations (Annexures P-2 & P-3). Mr.Dhull has placed on record order dated 07.12.2022 whereby the Divisional Commissioner, Ambala has granted the benefit of parole for a period of 6 weeks subject to various conditions. As per condition no.5, he has to furnish a personal bond and 2 sureties to the tune of Rs.1 lakh each, to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate, Sonipat.

Counsel has submitted that on an earlier occasion also, he had approached this Court for accepting personal bonds for releasing him as he is not in a position to put-forth the two sureties. It is submitted that in CRWP-745-2022 titled *Ravi Kumar Vs. State of Haryana & others*, decided on 28.01.2022, direction was issued to the District Magistrate, Sonipat for consideration who had granted the necessary benefit and the petitioner has duly surrendered thereafter.

Keeping in view the above, the District Magistrate, Sonipat shall consider the representation of the petitioner as and when it is made for exemption from furnishing the 2 sureties as directed by the Divisional Magistrate. Let the same be decided within a period of 2 weeks from the receipt of the representation.

Petition stands disposed of with the said directions.
