This is a petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 151 dated 13.5.2022, under Sections 21 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, (for short 'the Act') registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur

Earlier petition was withdrawn on 4th August, 2022 as proper instructions were not given to the counsel for the petitioner.

As per the case set up on 13.5.2022, police party acting upon a secret information apprehended Sanju and Akashdeep @ Aman Kundi (petitioner). 260 grams of Heroin was recovered from the possession of Sanju and 10 grams of Heroin was recovered from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 13.5.2022, investigation is complete and the recovery from the petitioner is of non-commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Paramjeet Singh opposes the prayer and submits that the petitioner is involved in two more cases.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering that though investigation is complete conclusion of trial is likely to take time, the recovery from the petitioner is of non-commercial quantity, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
