[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 13.07.2022, in CWP No.14384 of 2021 in case titled as 'Tara Chand versus State of Haryana and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.14384 of 2021 was disposed of vide order dated 13.07.2022 by directing the respondent to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 29.04.2021 by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 28.11.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 29.04.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is stated to have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner.

[5] However, taking into account the fact that order (Annexure P-

by passing a speaking order, noaction is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[6] Accordingly, the instant petition is *disposed of* as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 28.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law as well as to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if cause survives.
