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Reference by the Registry seen. The cheque deposited there is stated to be dated 13.12.2016. The validity period of a cheque is for three months from the date of issuance, which seems to have now expired.

The cheque was to be released in favour of the respondent. According to the report, respondent and her counsel have been informed accordingly, but they have not bothered to come and collect the cheque. Even otherwise, since the period of validity of cheque has expired, it is no longer legal and a valid instrument and no further correspondence in that regard either with the petitioner or the respondent is needed.
