The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.166 dated 28.09.2019 under Section 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have resolved their dispute and filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 19.08.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel does not disputed the factum of the parties having settled their dispute and also having filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, has further submitted that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 19.08.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
