1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 25.09.2018 in CWP-24470-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 25.09.2018 reveals that CWP-24470-2018 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim raised in the demand notice dated 10.08.2018 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been rejected vide order Annexure R-2/1-T and R-2/2-T dated 04.01.2019 and 19.12.2019 respectively, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order Annexure R-2/1-T and R-2/2-T dated 04.01.2019 and 19.12.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
