Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the instructions/letter dated 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-11) issued by the Sports Department, Haryana, clarifying earlier instructions dated 24.07.2019 (Annexure P-10) issued by respondent No.1 to the extent that the candidates shall submit the Sports Gradation Certificate up to 31.08.2019, as per notifications dated 25.05.2018 and 15.11.2018 (Annexures P-16 & P-17, respectively).

2. While issuing notice of motion, following order dated 01.11.2019 was passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Notice of motion.

On asking of Court, Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and seeks time to file reply. Let requisite number of copies of paper book be supplied to learned State Counsel during course of day, if not supplied earlier.

Learned State Counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that in matters of such nature pending before Hon'ble 1st Division Bench, learned Advocate General, Haryana has given undertaking that services of persons who have been appointed under Sports Category in the absence of Sports Gradation

Certificate would not be terminated and matters are pending for 03.12.2019.

Post this matter on 04.12.2019.

The same directions shall apply in the present writ petition also.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Division Bench of this Court, vide its judgment dated 09.10.2020 passed in LPA-1332-2019, has decided the matter and case of the petitioners is squarely covered with the judgment *ibid*.

4. Disposed of in terms of the Division Bench judgment rendered in LPA-1332-2019 with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Department in accordance with law.
