[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 23.08.2021, in CWP-16275-2021in case titled as '**Vidya Devi**versus**State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-16275-2021 was disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioner in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within four months.

[3] Pursuant to the notice issued to the respondent, learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 02.11.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.11.2022 by way of appropriate

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
