Petitioner is seeking regular bail in the case bearing FIR No.868 dated 13.12.2014, under Sections 498-A/406/506/323 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

It has not been disputed that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in terms of order dated 01.06.2018. It is not a case that he had surrendered in the trial Court. The petitioner was arrested and produced in the Court on 31.10.2022.

The Court of Sessions while dismissing the bail application has made following observations:-

“Resultantly, applicant is not entitled to concession of bail and bail application is accordingly rejected. However, learned trial Court shall make an endeavour to dispose off the case within two months, from today and in case, the case is not disposed off within two months, applicant may move an application for bail before the trial Court and trial Court shall release the applicant on bail subject to its satisfaction. However, he will not hamper the progress of the case during this period of two month and in case, he does not cooperate and tries to hamper the progress of the case, he shall not be entitled to the concession of bail in the aforesaid terms.

Keeping in view the indulgence shown by the Court of Session, no mitigating circumstances are made to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
