A perusal of the record would show that the status report in compliance with the order passed by this Court on 23.01.2020, has been filed. According to which, in Paras 2 and 3 of the same, it has been stated as follows:-

2. "That in due compliance of the order dated 23.01.2020 passed by this Hon'ble Court, it is submitted that possession proceedings were conducted by the Field Kanungo, Circle Dhablan District Patiala on 13.03.2020 who submitted his report vide No.25/F.K. Dated 13.03.2020. Copy of the report of possession proceedings is attached herewith as Annexure R-1. According to the report of the Field Kanungo Dhablan, Cattle rooms and Khurlis of cattle were removed from Khasra Nos.36, 37, 38 and 39 with the help of J.C.B. Machine. In some area of Khasra Nos.36, 37, 38 and 39 crop including Barseem was standing and the possession of standing crop was also taken over and delivered to the Panchayat

Officer, Patiala and Panchayat Secretary village Ucha Goan District Patiala by the Field Kanungo who was present on behalf of B.D.P.O. Office.

3. That in view of the above report submitted by the Field Kanungo, Dhablan, District Patiala, the possession of disputed land/shamlat land has already been taken on 13.03.2020 and the orders passed by this Hon'ble Court have been duly complied with."

A perusal of Annexure R-I also clearly specifies that the possession has been handed over to the Gram Panchayat.

In the light of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Petitioner is at liberty that if he has something to say, he may file an appropriate application supporting the same by documentary evidence and affidavit duly attested.
