Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the order dated 06.12.2021, vide which the bail/surety bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled by the trial Court in case/FIR No. 218 dated 03.11.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were granted the concession of interim bail, vide orders dated 09.01.2020 (Annexures P-3 & P-4) and thereafter, the *challan* was presented in their absence and the petitioners were not aware of the same.

After arguing for some time, finding that the Court is not convinced, learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer and submits that petitioners may be granted liberty to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court may be directed that if the petitioners move an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above limited prayer of the petitioner, this

petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the petitioners surrender before it within a period of seven days from today and move an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of three days thereafter.
