[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 18.03.2021, in CWP-6339-2021 in case titled as '**Dev Raj versus State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that while issuing notice of motion vide order dated 18.03.2021 for 26.05.2021, impugned order dated 26.02.2021 was stayed and the petitioner was directed to be posted either at Shahpur Kandi Township or at Ranjit Sagar Dam.

[3] Pursuant to the notice issued to respondent No.1, compliance report-cum-reply has been filed along with order (Annexure R-1) dated 19.11.2022, as per which, the petitioner has been posted at Shahpur Kandi Township in compliance of order (Annexure P-1). The same is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, she does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
