PANKAJ JAIN, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner sought directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.0081 dated 05.09.2021 registered under Sections 307/34 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Bhindi Sadan, District Amritsar, Rural.

2. Notice of motion was issued. Status report by way of affidavit dated 27.01.2020 was filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

3. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurjit Singh, informs that the cancellation report in the present case has been filed before the trial Court on 12.11.2020.

4. Mr. Gaurav Bhayya, Advocate brings to the notice of this Court the contents of status report dated 27.01.2020 especially para No.8 to contend that in fact the investigating agency is blowing hot and cold in the same breath.

5. Be that as it may, the fact remains that the cancellation report already stands submitted before the Court and the petitioner can raise protest against the same before the trial Court.

6. Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed, at this stage with liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial Court and ought to pursue alternate remedy as available under law.
