Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was duly selected and appointed as TGT Science in Mewat Cadre in pursuance to the Advertisement No.3 of 2015 dated 28.06.2015 but due to circumstances, which were beyond the control of the petitioner, the petitioner could not join the same within the offered time. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had approached the respondents for allowing him to join but no action is being taken by the respondents so as to allow the petitioner to join the post on which he was not only duly selected but was also issued appointment letter, hence, the respondents be directed to allow the petitioner to join the service in pursuance to the appointment letter dated 08.06.2020 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by filing a representation dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
