This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to register the FIR and to take strict legal action against respondents No.7 & 8 for sexually assaulting the petitioner and to further conduct a fair investigation on the complaint/representation dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner on which till date no action has been taken by the official respondents just because of the administrative position of respondents No.7 & 8 as they are the police officials of State of Haryana.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar , to consider and decide the representation dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) and dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-6) alleged to have been submitted by

the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off only with a direction to respondent No.3 that if any such representations, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
