[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 20.05.2019 in CWP No.13268 of 2019 in case titled as Meer Singh vs. M.D. University, Rohtak and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.13268 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent(s) to take appropriate decision in respect of admissibility of technical scales to the employees of the University within three months from the receipt of copy of the order and in case on decision, it was found that the petitioner was entitled for the benefit of technical scale which he was already drawing at the time of retirement, benefits of such orders be extended to the petitioner by re-fixing his pensionary benefits appropriately, within two months thereafter.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to orders, Annexure P/1 dated 20.05.2019, claim of the petitioner

was considered and rejected vide order, Annexure R/1 dated 18.11.2019,

therefore, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 18.11.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
