HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are working as Guest Teachers and are now being threatened with dislocation from the present place of posting on the ground that the Guest Teachers, who have been displaced so as to accommodate regular employees, are to be adjusted at their place, which is not at all envisaged in the transfer policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the displaced Guest Teachers are to be accommodated at the place, which are vacant and are not to be adjusted, where other Guest Teachers are already working.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 14.11.2022 (Annexure P-10 Collly.) but the same is still pending

consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at

this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the claim of the petitioners in the representation dated 14.11.2022 (Annexure P-10 Collly.) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the representation, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 14.11.2022 (Annexure P-10 Collly.), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It is directed that till a decision is taken on the representation filed by the petitioners, no coercive action of their displacement will be taken by the respondent-department.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
