[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 18.08.2022, in CWP-18012-2022 in case titled as '**Bir Chand** versus **State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondent has filed short reply on behalf of the respondent along with copy of speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 09.12.2022, accepting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 15.05.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that although the claim of the petitioner has been decided yet the petitioner has not been released full payment as per entitlement, therefore, although, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 09.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner.
