This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the impugned orders dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-9) and 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) passed by office respondent No.3, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

The counsel for the respondent-University has brought the copies of order bearing Nos.CUH/2022/Estt.Sec./T/1124 and CUH/2022/Estt.Sec./T/1125, both dated 19.12.2022, vide which the

orders impugned in the present petition have been withdrawn. The counsel has further submitted that necessary consequential benefits on account of withdrawal of orders impugned in the present petition, shall automatically be released in favour of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition.
