Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has requisite experience, for which, she is entitled for the grant of marks but the same has not been given to her by the respondents despite the fact that the experience certificate was presented before the authorities concerned at the time of interview. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once the experience certificate was presented before the authorities concerned, it was incumbent upon the respondents to take the same into consideration and grant the benefit of the same to the petitioner while assessing merit of the petitioner but in the present case while declaring the final result, the petitioner has not been given marks for experience, which is causing prejudice to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by

way of filing a representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.4 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/9), respondent No.4 is directed to decide the representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/9) by passing a speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
