[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 08.08.2022 in CRM-M No.35107 of 2022.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has been supplied copy of short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Jaskaran Singh, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar along with Annexures R/1 to R/3 dated 18.08.2022, 03.10.2022 and 06.10.2022 i.e. letter to ACP South, statement of petitioner and compliance report. He further states that as per compliance report, Annexure R/3 dated 06.10.2022, representation filed by the petitioner was decided and claim of the petitioner contained therein was rejected. In the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition at this stage but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge compliance report, Annexure R/3 dated 06.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as

not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
