By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P-7) passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana passed in FIR No.55 dated 14.03.2017 registered for offences punishable under Sections 379, 323, 341, 427, 506, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 379-B was added later on) at Police Station Division 7, District Ludhiana vide which bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the absence on behalf of the petitioner was on account of ailment that he suffered on account of accidental injury. Reliance is being placed on Annexures P-8 to P-12.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, DAG, Punjab., appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the records of the case.

Present petition is disposed off with the liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within 7 days from today. In case the petitioner surrenders and prays for admission of bail, such prayer if any made by the petitioner shall be decided within 7 days thereafter in accordance with law.
