This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., 1973 with a prayer for quashing the impugned order dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-6) arising out of Complaint No.56 of 2014 dated 08.12.2014 titled 'Puran Singh Vs. Gurmeet Singh and others' (Annexure P-1) filed before the learned JMIC, Moga, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Vide order dated 16.01.2020 while issuing notice, the operation of proclamation order dated 08.03.2019 was stayed during the pendency of the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the complainant has died and vide order dated 24.02.2022, he has been discharged by the Court of learned JMIC, Moga. The order dated 24.02.2022 is taken on

record.

In view of above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Needless to mention here that since the petitioner has been discharged in the main complaint itself, therefore, all the interim orders passed in that case including the order dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-6) whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender, merges into the final order and no further order is required to be passed.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
