The instant petition has been filed seeking regular bail in FIR No.605, dated 13.12.2019, under Sections 379-A, 411 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was made to suffer a disclosure statement while in custody in FIR No. 162 dated 13.12.2019, under Sections 307, 224, 332, 353, 186, 130, 148, 149, 201, 483, 411, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur. In the present case, the allegation is that two un-identified persons have snatched the motor cycle of the complainant along-with his driving licence and documents of the said motor cycle.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. He, on instructions from SI Baldev Singh, submits that the snatched motor cycle has been recovered in view of disclosure statements made by the present petitioner and his co-accused namely Lakhwinder Singh. The petitioner is behind the bars since 11.12.2020 and is also involved in other cases, details of which are mentioned in para 11 of the present petition.

Keeping in view the afore-said facts, coupled with the facts that the petitioner is behind the bars for almost two years; recovery of the snatched motor cycle has already been made; challan stands presented; and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time as out of total 17 prosecution witnesses none has been examined so far; petitioner is granted bail on his furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Accordingly the present petition is allowed.
