While finding the following anomalies in the demarcation report submitted, the Executing Court has ordered a fresh demarcation:-

“1. The demarcation has been conducted with DGPS Satellite surveyor instead of Theodolite and Total Station Machine as mentioned in the order of Hon'ble High Court.

2. The demarcation has been conducted by considering a passage as pucca point, but the report is silent as to confirmation from three sides regarding correctness of this pucca point as per High court rules and orders.

3. The site plan has been prepared by DGPS surveyor, but there is no mention of the longitude and latitude etc. as are considered in GPS demarcation by Theodolite and Total Station Machine.

4. In khasra number the name of village and its had bast number has been wrongly mentioned. If the same is result of manual input by the operator of machine, it shows that online use of GPS was not there. If the same is result of GPS use, it must follow that the site plan is not of the disputed property. No supplementary report or site plan with correct details has been received.”

The petitioners have filed the revision petition challenging the correctness of the aforesaid order passed by the Executing Court..

This Bench has heard the learned counsel representing the petitioner at length and with his able assistance perused the paperbook.

The learned counsel representing the petitioners failed to draw the attention of the Court to any prejudice caused to them.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
