[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 09.08.2022 in CWP No.7007 of 2020 in case titled as Rajender Singh vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.7007 of 2020 was disposed of by directing respondent No.3 therein to decide legal notice dated 25.08.2019 by passing appropriate speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] Pursuant to the notice issued to the respondent, learned DAG has produced copy of order dated 28.11.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 25.08.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 28.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
