[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 04.07.2022 in CWP No.13401 of 2022 in case titled as Rajpal Singh vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.13401 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to look into the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 01.04.2022 served by the petitioner and to pass an administrative order in respect thereto in accordance with law within six weeks.

[3] Learned AAG has produced copy of speaking order dated 02.12.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner qua conveyance allowance and extension in service from 58 years to 60 years while accepting the claim for leave encashment benefit. The same is taken on record. Copy

thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge speaking order dated 02.12.2022 to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
