Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her son and to take appropriate action on complaint dated 15.11.2022, Annexure P-4, submitted by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's marriage was solemnized with respondent No.6 on 28.12.2012 and a male child was born out of the wedlock. He submits that her husband was a drug addict and has been torturing and tormenting the petitioner as a result of which, she was compelled to leave her matrimonial home. He submits that in order to earn a living, the petitioner started running a boutique but on 01.08.2022, respondent No.6 entered her shop and damaged the articles. Counsel submits that pressure has also been built on the

petitioner as a Will has been executed by the petitioner's parents-in-law in favour of her son. According to the counsel, representation, Annexure P-4, has been submitted to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, but no action has been taken. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the same.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Grewal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on their behalf.

Having heard counsel for the parties and considering the nature of prayer made, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar - respondent No.4 to examine the representation, Annexure P-4, and to take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
