1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.05.2019, in CWP-13728-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-13728-2019, was disposed of vide order dated 22.05.2019, by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 04.01.2019 in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the competent authority arrived at a conclusion that the benefits claimed by the petitioner were admissible, consequential benefits were to be released to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of speaking order dated 24.12.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in view of the petitioner's representation having been rejected, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be

24.12.2019 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
