The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 202 dated 30.07.2022 registered under Section 379-A IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a 19 years young boy and has falsely been implicated in the present case; that even the colour and registration number of the motor cycle used in the occurrence has not been disclosed by the complainant and that the petitioner has been in custody since 09.08.2022.

Learned State counsel, while vehemently opposing the prayer for bail, submits that the motorcycle used in the occurrence was also stolen by the petitioner qua which FIR No. 336 dated 23.06.2022 has been registered at Police Station Industrial area Sector-29, Panipat. The mobile of complainant-Pooja was snatched when she was on her way to the tuition. The motor-cycle

and the mobile of the complainant have been recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is a habitual offender and if he is released on bail, there are chances that he may involve himself in more similar type of cases.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the documents on record.

Since the motor-cycle used in the occurrence was a stolen one and by using the same the petitioner snatched the mobile of complainant and the recovery of motor cycle and mobile phone stands recovered from him and he is involved in one another case, thus, this Court is of the view that if, the petitioner is released on bail, he may involved himself in more cases.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
