The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.18 dated 31.1.2022 registered under sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC at Police Station, Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar Rural along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that parties have amicably settled their dispute and they have arrived at a compromise and hence prosecution of the petitioners in the present FIR is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Ravi Rana, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.2 & 3.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh submits that matter is under investigation.

Learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 submits that respondent no.3 has to go abroad for her further studies within a period of

two weeks.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternate remedies as may be available to them in accordance with law. The investigating agency is directed to complete the investigation expeditiously and preferably within a period of one month from today.
