The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 11.04.2022 (Annexure P-8) in case FIR No. 661 dated 05.08.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 452, 506 and 34 IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 3 (2)(V) of the SC & ST Act registered at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, District Karnal.

On 30.11.2022, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that in the present case, the matter has been compromised and the petitioner alongwith co-accused namely Ajay have filed a petition bearing No.CRM-M-54942- 2022 for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.*

*Notice of motion for 20.12.2022.*

*Till the next date of hearing, the operation of order dated*

*11.04.2022 (Annexure P-8) is stayed.  
To be heard alongwith CRM-M-54942-2022.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had also filed a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise alongwith co-accused Ajay and the said CRM-M-54942-2022 has been allowed by an order of even date and the FIR has been quashed on the basis of the compromise qua the petitioner and said co-accused Ajay.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the said facts.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.04.2022 is set aside.
