The instant petition has been preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1959, seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to immediately transfer the motor connection Khata/Account No.AP91/2070, from the name of respondent No.4 Amarjit Singh to the name of the petitioner installed in Khasra No.20//20/2, 28//16, 17, 24/2 situated at village Kahlwan, Sub Tehsil Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has purchased the aforesaid land and that the electricity connection ought to have been transferred in her favour, however, the petitioner is being shown as owner only to the extent of the share purchased by her. He contends that the petitioner approached the respondents for transfer of the motor connection, but needful has not been done.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Kashish Sahni, Advocate, enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3. She contends that the present petition is misconceived and a civil suit is already pending before the District Courts, Jalandhar and even otherwise also, the petitioner has an efficacious remedy under the statutory framework by approaching the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum, for the aforesaid relief.

Faced with above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
