[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 11.10.2018 in LPA No.191 of 2017.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that LPA No.191 of 2017 was disposed of by accepting the appeal and directing the respondents to consider the case of the appellant in the light of the observations made in LPA No. 191 of 2017.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the notice issued in the instant petition, compliance report along with speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 18.10.2020 has been filed rejecting the claim of the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 18.10.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as

not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.

[5] Rule discharged.

[6] In view of decision of the Contempt Petition, all connected applications also stand disposed of.
