[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.07.2019, in CWP No.4295 of 2019 in case titled as 'Parduman Singh versus State of Punjab through Financial Commissioner and Secretary to Government of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.4295 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the legal notice and pass a speaking order in respect thereto within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order (Annexure P-1), respondent No.2 has passed order dated 04.02.2020, rejecting the claim of the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 04.02.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
