Prayer in this petition is for quashing of case/Calendra No. 310/2022, report No. 16 dated 04.11.2022, under Sections 107/150 Cr.P.C. at Police Station Division No. 7, Jalandhar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his arguments and submits that after registration of the aforesaid Calendra, the petitioner has given a representation (Annexure P-4) to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar against her false implication as the petitioner and her daughter are residing in a rented accommodation, whereas the other parties, i.e her husband and son, have come to her place carrying a revolver, however, no action has been taken on the complaint/representation of the petitioner, therefore, a direction may be issued to respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to decide the said representation.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to decide the aforesaid representation in accordance with law, within a period of two months from today.
