Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the present petition has been filed for the grant of interim regular bail for 07 days to the petitioner so as to allow him to attend the marriage of his real sister, which is scheduled to be held on 27.11.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that on earlier occasion also, keeping in view the marriage of the brother of the petitioner, the petitioner was extended the benefit of interim bail, which benefit was not misused by the petitioner and the petitioner surrendered before the jail authorities after availing the said benefit of interim bail hence, keeping in view the bonafide on the part of the petitioner, he be granted the same benefit, keeping in view the marriage of his real sister.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Teevar Sharma, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 27.11.2022 but submits that as per his instructions, the petitioner has siblings, who can take care of his sister's marriage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Learned State counsel is not disputing the fact that the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 27.11.2022. It has also been conceded by the learned State counsel that on earlier occasion the petitioner was granted the benefit of interim bail, keeping in view the marriage of his brother, which benefit has not been misused by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstance of the present case, the petitioner is extended the benefit of interim bail starting from 26.11.2022 till 01.12.2022 subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petitioner is directed to report back to the jail authorities on 01.12.2022 before 5 p.m.

Petition stands allowed.
