The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9.

Notice of motion was issued to the respondents and Mr. Ajay Kamboj, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 4 to 9 and has filed a detailed reply to the instant petition. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners have placed on record a marriage certificate dated 19.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) before this Court, wherein, the date of marriage has been shown to be 19.11.2022, whereas, they have produced a different marriage certificate before the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel further submits that the marriage certificate produced by the petitioners before the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Sri Mukatsar Sahib was forged and fabricated.

Learned counsel for the respondents No. 4 to 9, while referring to the order dated 29.11.2022 passed by the Court of Shri Raj Kumar, learned Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, further submits that the petitioners had filed a petition before the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, claiming similar relief and they had made a statement that they did not feel threatened any more and did not want to proceed ahead with the petition filed before the said Court.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners could not refute the said contention.

In view of this, the instant petition deserves to be dismissed.

Ordered accordingly.

However, so far as the averments made by the respondents No. 4 to 9 relating to the alleged forgery of marriage certificate are concerned, the respondents No. 4 to 9 are at liberty to avail their alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
