ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus to grant same working day and gazette holidays which are being granted to other Class-IV employees working in Transport Department, Haryana from the date of appointment of the petitioners and arrears be released to the petitioners with market rate interest.

2. *Qua*their grievance, petitioners have also served final demand notice dated 18.09.2022 (Annexure P-11), but the same has not been adverted by respondents till date. Hence the petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending final demand notice dated 18.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners also seeks decision on the pending representation, as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the pending final demand notice dated 18.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) of the petitioners, and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
