Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner in the present petition is to grant the petitioner the benefit of modified first and second ACP scale as the petitioner was eligible for the modified first ACP scale as on 01.01.1996 and second modified ACP scale in the year 2004.

Learned counsel submits that after issuance of notice of motion, the respondents themselves have issued the instructions dated 26.10.2017, according to which the claim of the petitioner is liable to be allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the respondents by way of filing a representation and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, the said representation is decided by the respondents in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in case, the petitioner makes any representation placing reliance on the instructions dated 26.10.2017 issued by the respondents, to claim the benefit as raised in the present petition, the said representation will be decided in accordance with law by keeping in view the said instructions dated 26.10.2017, within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further, with the liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
