In compliance of the last order, the alleged *detenue* Pooja is present in the Court and this Court has interacted with the alleged *detenue* Pooja. She states that her marriage was solemnized with the petitioner on 27.02.2022. However, after the marriage, she was harassed and tortured by her husband and his family members. Consequently, she left the matrimonial home and at present is staying with her parents. She wants to stay with her parents and does not want to join the company of the petitioner.

In view of the statement made by the alleged *detenue* Pooja, the instant petition deserves to be dismissed. Ordered accordingly.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail alternative remedies, in accordance with law.
