The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking quashing of FIR No.64 dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was dispute with respect to a sum of Rs.28 Lacs between petitioner and respondent No.2. The police on the asking of respondent No.2 registered aforesaid FIR. The petitioner was made to join investigation and during the course of investigation, the matter was settled between the parties. The matter was settled in the presence of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sunam, who vide report dated 26.10.2022 (Annexure P-6) confirmed receipt of payment by respondent No.2 and settlement of the matter.

Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 02.12.2022, confirming that matter has been settled between the parties.

The status report filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.

Keeping in mind that parties have amicably settled the issues; alleged offence is a compoundable offence and that State has no objection to quashing of FIR, petition is allowed and accordingly, FIR No.64 dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Section 420 IPC and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua the petitioner.
