The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.103 dated 26.04.2015 registered under Sections 363 and 366(A) IPC at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 31.10.2019 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the parties.

On 05.11.2019 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Prayer made in this petition is for quashing of FIR and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise/affidavit between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner and respondent No.2 are staying together as husband and wife.

Notice of motion for 27.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their respective statements with regard to compromise/settlement on 13.12.2019.

The Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court is directed to submit a report along with copies of statements of parties on or before the next date of hearing containing the following information as well:-

- (i) Number of persons arrayed as accused in FIR;
- (ii) Whether any accused is proclaimed offender;
- (iii) The stage of trial/proceedings;
- (iv) Whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary, and without any coercion or undue influence.”

As per report dated 14.12.2019 of the Judicial Magistrate Ist

Class, Amritsar the parties did not appear before the Trial Court in terms of the afore quoted order of this Court.

The petitioner has also been declared a proclaimed offender.

In the light of the above, no merit is found in the instant petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.
