ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel submits that the charges were framed way back on 19.02.2018 and the present petition was filed on 21.09.2017.

Since the judicial order was passed for framing of charges, as such, the present petition filed under Section 482 CrPC for quashing of FIR without challenging the framing of charges, is not maintainable.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file a petition for challenging the framing of charges, if so desire. It is made clear in case such petition is filed, the time for which the present petition was pending before this Court, shall not be counted while calculating the delay in challenging the framing of charges. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
