The instant petition has been filed seeking regular bail in FIR No.25, dated 17.02.2019, under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 398, 401 IPC, registered at Police Station Pillu Khera, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner jumped the bail on account of the fact that he was in custody in another case i.e. FIR No. 70, dated 17.02.2022, under Section 380 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Jijaha, Uttar Pradesh. It is asserted that the name of the petitioner has been surfaced on the basis of disclosure statement of his co-accused namely Manjee @ Romeo and firstly, he was arrested on 19.02.2019 along-with his co-accused. It is further asserted that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner in any manner whatsoever.

Custody certificate of the petitioner filed by the counsel for the State is taken on record.

Learned State counsel also did not controvert the afore-said fact.

The petitioner has not played an active role in any manner and could not appear before the Court as he was behind the bars in another FIR i.e. FIR No. 70, dated 17.02.2022. However, a perusal of the record shows that the petitioner failed to appear before the Court on 21.02.2022 and even earlier on 07.01.2022 and finally on 10.03.2022 on one pretext or the other, which is not justifiable at all.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and to meet the ends of justice, the petitioner is granted bail on his furnishing surety/bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Accordingly, the present petition stands allowed.
