[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 25.02.2019 in CWP No.4849 of 2019 in case titled as Amarjit Singh vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.4849 of 2019 was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations filed by the petitioner within three months from the receipt of certified copy of the order and in case, it was found that the petitioner was entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the representations, the same be paid to him within three months thereafter.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, pursuant to time taken by learned State Counsel on 06.11.2019 to obtain instruction in the matter, reply dated 27.02.2020 along with Speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 25.06.2019 and letter, Annexure R/2 dated 23.01.2020 has been filed.

speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 25.06.2019, the petitioner has been released pension as per his entitlement, however, interest on the delayed payment of pension has not been paid to him and in the circumstances, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to make a claim in accordance with law for payment of interest on the delayed release of pension.

[5] The same is not opposed to by the learned Addl. A.G.

[6] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
